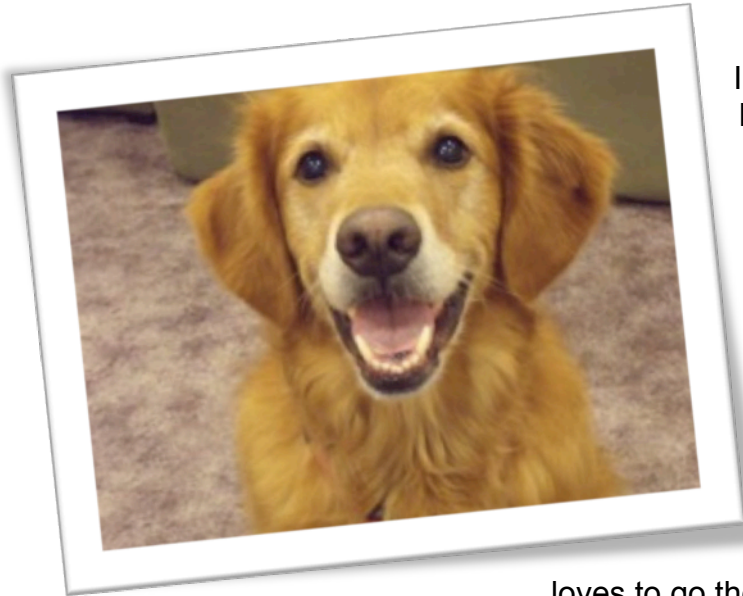


09-098 Max
