



## ADOPTION REQUIREMENTS

### The adopter(s):

- Will take the dog to a vet clinic within 14 days of adoption for a check-up.
- Are personally responsible for the humane care, proper food, water, shelter, regular exercise, veterinary care, and control of their GRRoW Golden at all times.
- Will treat the golden as a household pet. Therefore, at all times and under all circumstances, the golden must reside inside the house at the adopter's address and shall not be kept confined exclusively to one area of the house.
- Understand(s) the GRRoW Golden will be spayed or neutered prior to entering the adopter's home.
- Understand(s) if they wish to relinquish custody of the dog, they must return it to GRRoW. No refund of the adoption application fee and adoption fee will be granted. They also shall not sell or transfer ownership to any other person, business or organization other than GRRoW.
- Agree(s) the Golden shall not be tied out (chained, roped, etc.) at the applicant's home without supervision.
- Understand(s) that if any GRRoW Golden is not receiving proper care (determined by GRRoW), GRRoW may request the dog be surrendered back to GRRoW. If the applicant refuses, GRRoW will contact the proper authorities to investigate the treatment of the dog, and if necessary, remove the Golden from the home.
- Agree(s) to allow GRRoW to examine the dog and its living conditions at any time, and to surrender the dog back to GRRoW if the conditions are found to be unsatisfactory. Should it be necessary to litigate in connection with any dispute, the adopter(s) agrees to pay all court costs and all attorney fees.
- Agree(s) to not let the Golden run at large or become a public nuisance. If the dog escapes, they also agree to take immediate responsibility to retrieve the dog from any shelter or impound.
- Agree(s) to fully supervise the Golden and keep it under control when outside in an unfenced area.
- Agree(s) to have the Golden wear a collar and ID tag at all times with current license.
- Shall not transport the Golden in an open vehicle or leave a choke/training collar on when unattended.
- Accepts this dog as is, assumes all risk of ownership, including the risk of injury or damage caused by the animal. GRRoW does not warrant the temperament or behavior of the rescue dog, nor is the rescue dog warranted to be free of genetic defects. The selection and adoption of the rescue dog is based upon the adopter's own observations and judgment, along



with the foster home's observations while the dog was in foster care. GRRoW is not liable for any acts by the rescue dog while living with the adopting family. The adopter(s) understands that GRRoW has made every effort to provide a Golden that is compatible with the adopter's home and living environment.

Understand(s) if any of the above conditions are not fulfilled, GRRoW reserves the right to remove the dog from the adopter's home without refunding the application fee and adoption fee. Should GRRoW have to remove a Golden from the adopter's home or property, it will not be considered trespassing, and the homeowner(s) shall not accuse GRRoW or its representative(s) of such actions.
